

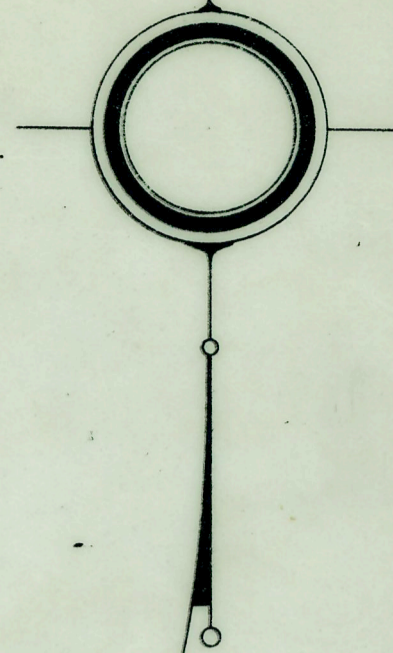

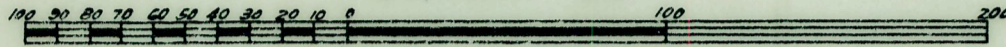

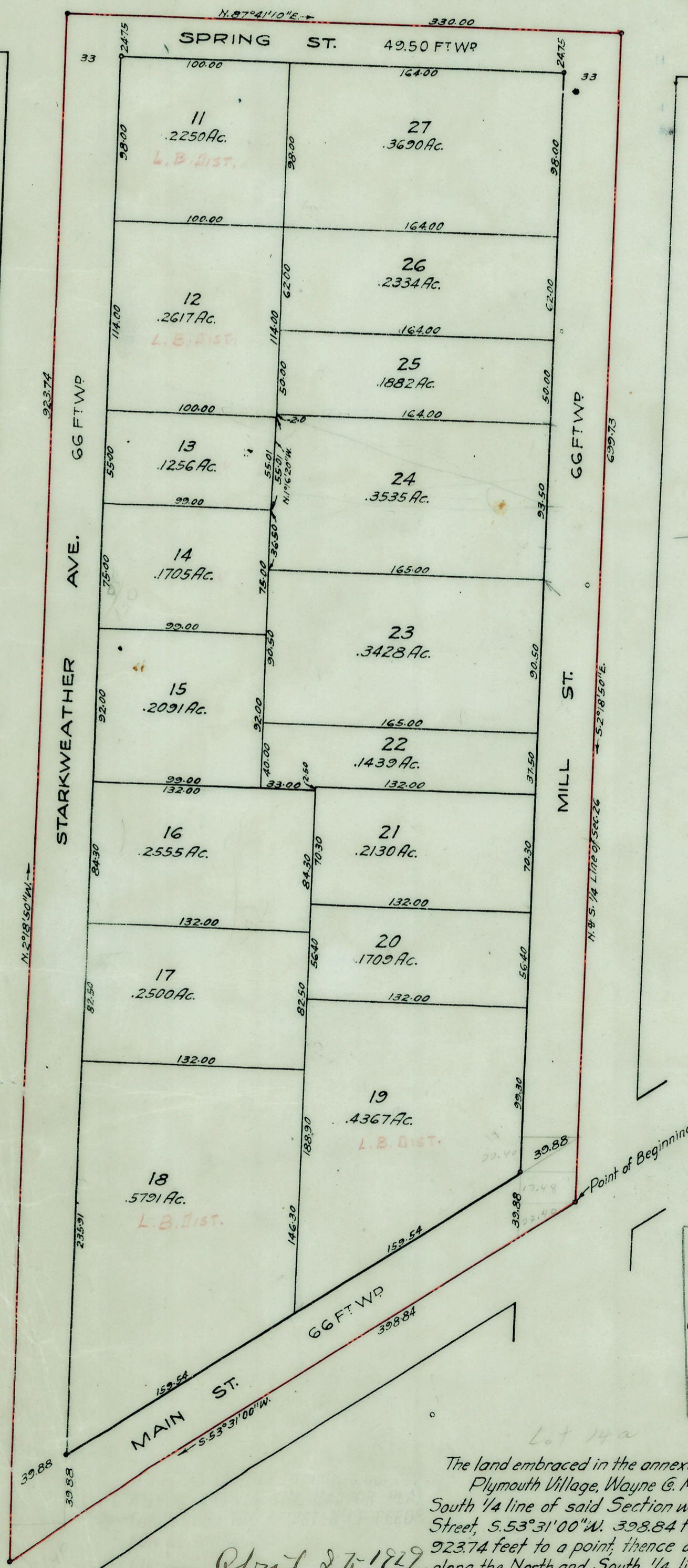

DESCRIPTION
The land embraced in the annexed plat of Assessor's Plymouth Sub. No 2 of Part of N.W. 1/4 of Section 26, T. 15. R. 8 E. Plymouth Village, Wayne Co. Mich. is described as follows: Beginning at a point at the intersection of the North and South 1/4 line of said Section with the centerline of Main Street and running thence along the centerline of said Main Street, 5.53°31'00"W. 398.84 feet to a point; thence along the centerline of Starkweather Avenue, N. 2°18'50"W. 923.74 feet to a point; thence along the centerline of Spring Street, N. 87°41'10"E. 330.00 feet to a point; thence along the North and South 1/4 line of said Section, S. 2°18'50"E. 699.73 feet to the point of beginning.
