Description of Land Platted.

The land embraced in the annexed plat of Geo. A. Starkweathers' subdivision on the N.E. 1/4 of the N.W. 1/4 of Section 26 in T. 13. N. 3. E. is described as follows. Commencing at a post 189.75 feet South on the W. line of said section, and 33 feet S. 89° 53' 20" of the N.E. 1/4 post of said section. Thence running South along the W. line of Mill Street 247.75 feet to a post on the E. line of Liberty St. Thence along said line S. 89° 53' 20". 264 feet to the E. line of Oak St. Thence along the East line of Oak St. North 405.75 feet to a post on the E. line of Division St. Thence along said line N. 83° 53' E. 132 feet. Thence South 57.75 feet. Thence N. 89° 53' E. 132 feet to the point of beginning.

Know all men by these presents that we Geo. A. Starkweathers as proprietor and Amelia Starkweathers, his wife, of Wayne County Michigan have caused the land embraced in the annexed plat to be surveyed laid out and platted to be known as Geo. A. Starkweathers' Subdivision and that the streets and alleys, as shown on said plat are hereby dedicated to the use of the public.

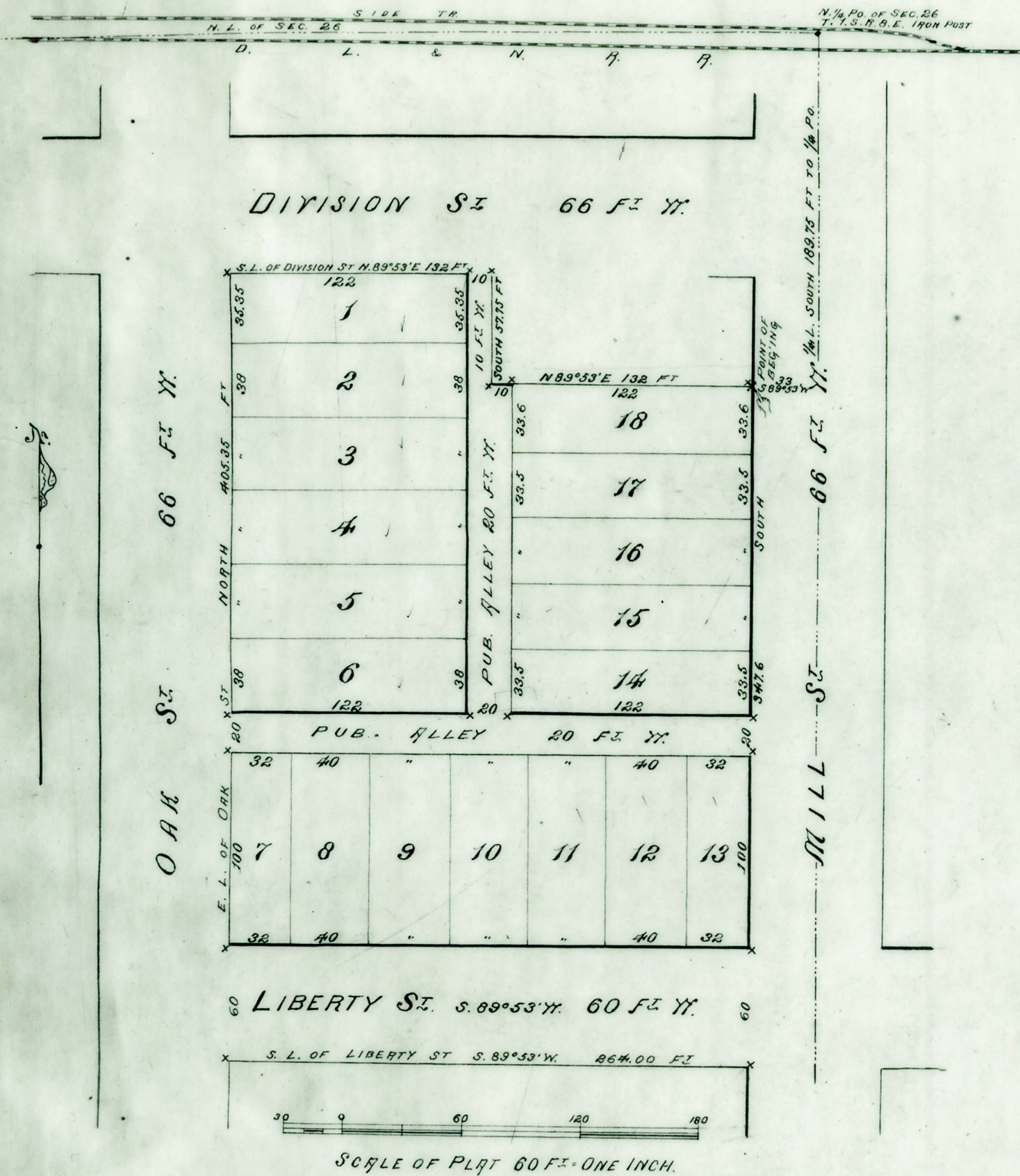
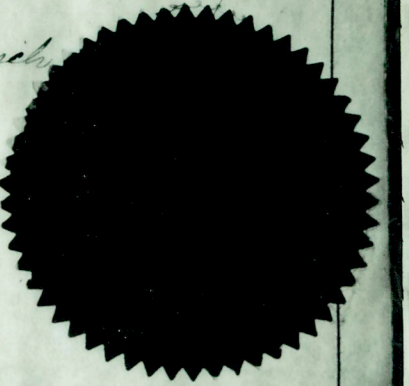
