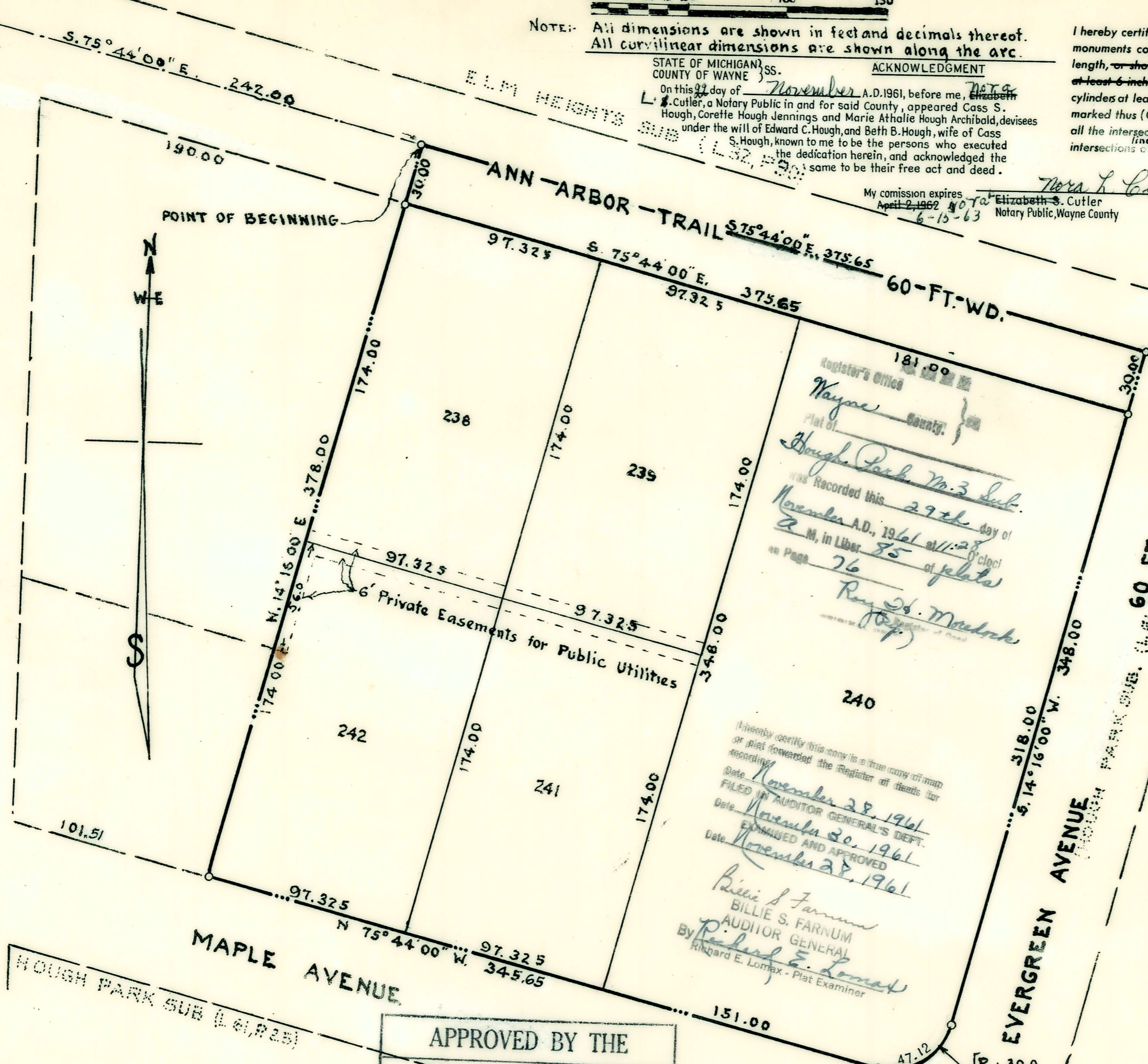

DESCRIPTION: - The land embraced in the annexed plat of Hough Park No. 3 Sub. of part of the S.E. 1/4 of Sec. 27, T.1 S., R.8 E., City of Plymouth, Wayne County, Michigan, comprises lots 238 to 242, both inclusive, and is described as follows: - Beginning at a point on the center line of Ann Arbor Trail, 60 feet wide, distant S. 75° 44' 00" E. 242.00 feet from the intersection of said center line with the north and south quarter corner line of said Sec. 27, running thence S. 75° 44' 00" E. along the said center southerly line of Ann Arbor Trail 375.65 feet; Thence S. 14° 16' 00" W. along the westerly line of Evergreen Avenue, 60 feet wide, 348.00 feet; Thence southwesterly an arc distance of 47.12 feet along a tangent curve concave to the northwest, radius 30.00 feet, whose chord bears S. 59° 16' 00" W. and is 42.43 feet long; Thence N. 75° 44' 00" W. along the northerly line of Maple Avenue, 60 feet wide, 345.65 feet; Thence N. 14° 16' 00" E. 378.00 feet to the point of beginning.
