

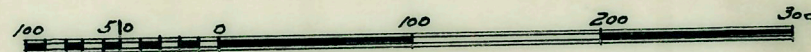

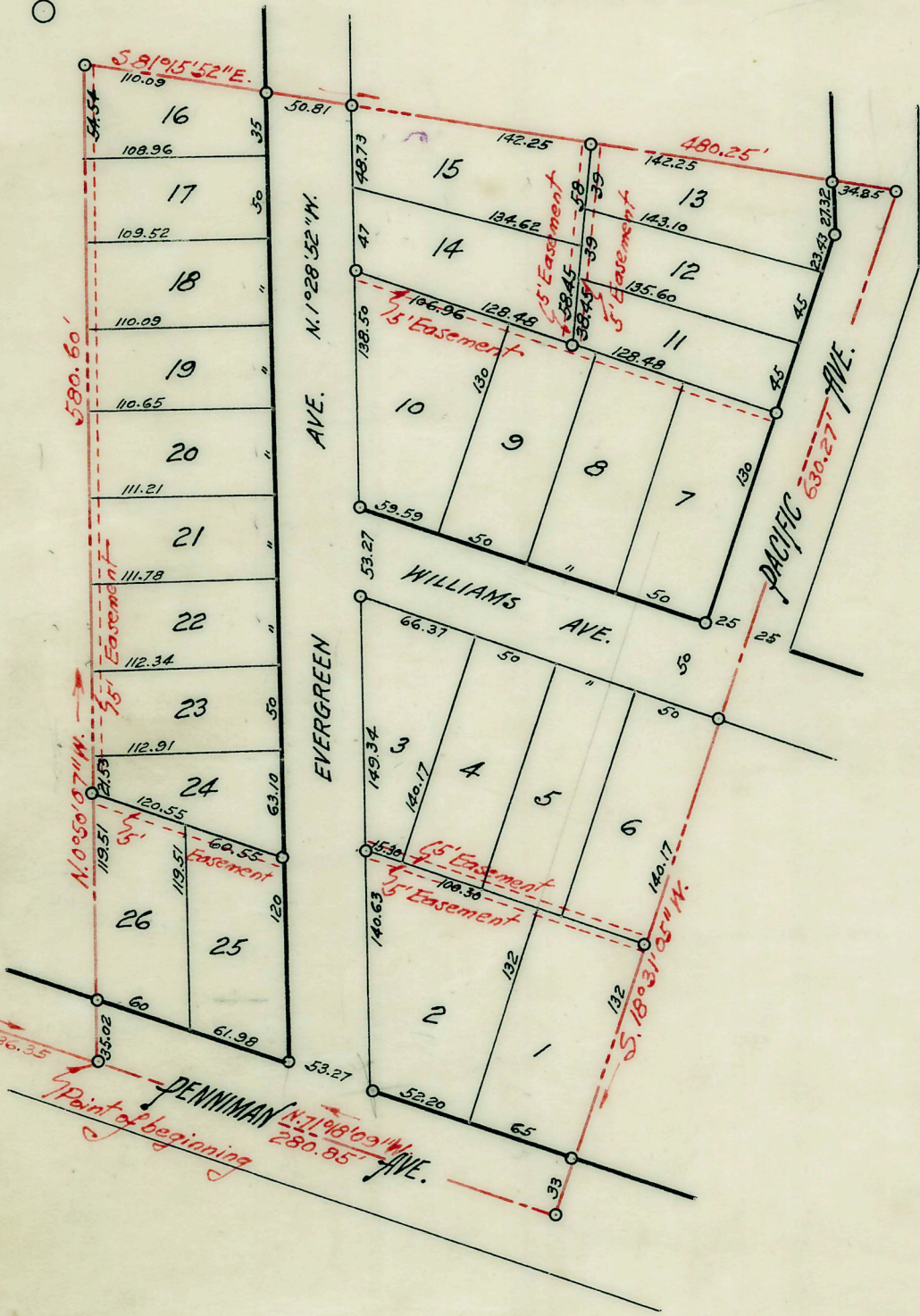

DESCRIPTION.

The land embraced in the annexed plat of "Mardale Sub." of part of N.E. 1/4 of sec. 27 T.1 S.R.8 E. Plymouth Village Wayne Co. Mich. is described as follows: Beginning at a point in the center of Penniman Ave. and at the S.E. corner of Oberkueffer and Thomas' Virginia Park Sub., and running thence N. 60° 07' W. 580.60 ft. to a point; thence S. 81° 15' 52" E. 480.25 ft. to a point; thence S. 18° 31' 05" W. 630.27 ft. to a point; thence N. 71° 18' 09" W. 280.85 ft. to the point of beginning.
