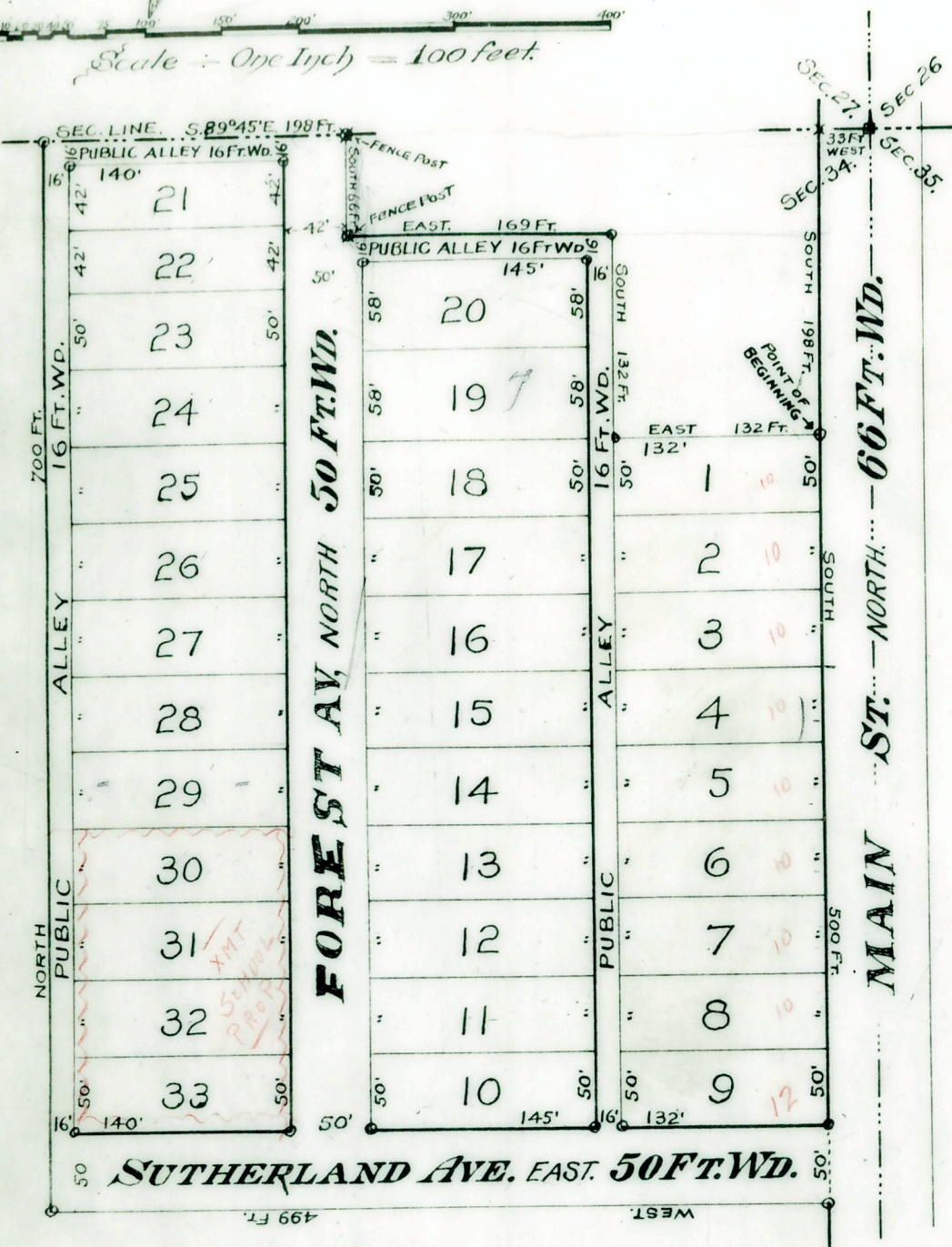

Description of land platted.
Beginning at a point 33 feet west, and 175 feet south of Section corner between Sections 26, 27, 34 and 35, T. 18. N. R. 8. E. Township of Plymouth, Wayne County, Michigan, and running thence on a course South 500 feet, to an iron post at the S.W. corner Sutherland, Adams and South Street, Thence West on the south line of Sutherland Adams 499 feet, to an iron post, Thence North 770 feet, to an iron post on the Section line between Sections 27 and 34, Thence S. 89° 45' E. 178 feet, to a fence post, Thence South 66 feet, to a fence post, Thence East 169 feet, to an iron post, Thence South 132 feet, to an iron post, Thence East 132 feet to the point of beginning.

I hereby certify that the plat herein delineated is a correct one, and that permanent monuments, consisting of 1/2 inch iron rods by 15 inches long have been placed at points marked thus (o) as thereon shown at all angles in the boundaries of the land platted, and at all intersections of streets or streets and alleys.
